RE: S.372: Artist-Museum Partnership Act

Dear Senator (*last name*):

I am writing to you today to request your support for S. 372: Artist—Museum Partnership Act. This bill, introduced on February 14, 2005, will amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 “to provide that a deduction equal to fair market value shall be allowed for charitable contributions of literary, musical, artistic, or scholarly compositions created by the donor.”

This law will encourage artists to donate their work to museums and other art non-profit organizations, which in turn can increase revenue streams for these same non-profits. I request that you to add your name to the list of sponsors for this bill, and take whatever action is necessary to pass it into law.
